1. Call to Order

Mayor Gene Schoonover called the meeting of the Board of Aldermen to order at 7 p.m., July 16, 2013. Mayor Schoonover led the pledge to the flag.

2. Roll Call

3. Approve Agenda

4. Streets in Hubbard Place – Carol Brown

Several residents of Hubbard Place were present to discuss the drainage changes after the streets were repaved. They asked if there could be any recourse on the contractor and asked for a copy of the engineering specifications that were used on the project.

Ed and Jan Shrewsbury have purchased the property at 705 Oak Street. Mr. Shrewsbury was present to request a designated alley behind his building. He also requested that the City extend his property 30' south.

21. Adjourn


